

Below are the minutes to the MileHi R/C Club meeting held July 10, 2010.

Meeting was called to order at 9:30 AM at the flying field by the Treasurer, Robert Plant. The President and Vice President were not present. There is no Secretary.

Fifteen (15) members were present providing a quorum.

The previous meeting's minutes were approved.

Both the Treasurer's and the Investment reports were approved. We adequate funding in both the checking and the investment accounts to proceed forward.

The Treasurer provided a membership report:

Summary: There 66 dues paying members. There 78 members with voting privileges.

Contests/Events Report:

The Boy Scout Day event held on June 26th was a great success. Other than printing costs, the net cost to the club was \$8.50. (We netted \$75 on concessions and paid out \$83.50 for food/pop/etc.) Over 50 Boy Scouts and their leaders were entertained with flying activities including buddy boxes, making models, and flying demos. John Neumeier donated (2) gallons of fuel and a bag of chips to offset the costs. George Kerr and John made this happen.

George and John are also engineering the Pluckrose Fly-In project that will be aimed at all types of flying. John presented the details. See the flier that is attached in PDF form.

Field Maintenance Report:

A roll of "Hot Pink" duct tape will be placed a top the flag/first aid locker for marking fabric damage locations to be repaired. When the duct tape appears (the Tooth Fairy will buy it and place it on the locker), tear off a short piece and stick it on the runway at the damaged spot.

Having said that, please check for damage after YOU have hit the runway (or taxiway) with something.

No Safety Report

Unfinished Business:

We are still trying to resolve the weed spraying issue at the old flying site. Hopefully, a letter will be written to the State of Colorado to take action.

Field Operating and Safety Rules are still in limbo. These have to be in place by the AMA sanctioned Pluckrose event. Since no one has acted on this, a Tooth Fairy team will get this done in a timely fashion.

The Lock Box (flag locker) is completed and installed thanks to Jim Hebert. This item is closed.

New Business:

The Pluckrose Fly-IN was approved for October 2nd.

Nominations for club officers and board members and other Tooth Fairies will close August 31st. If you have a name to submit or wish to volunteer/submit your name, please reply to me. We have several names so far but would like to see more.

The election/drafting will be in September and those elected/drafted will be installed in October.

A Neighborhood Fun Fly was proposed and passed to occur on the third Saturday in August...Aug 21st. It will be a club flying day with lunch served. Fliers will be placed in the surrounding neighbor's paper boxes announcing the event and inviting them out to see what happens at our field. Please plan to come out and fly and enjoy lunch. A good turn out of club members would be impressive.

The next club meeting will be August 7th at 9:30 AM at the flying field. Please come to the meeting and enjoy the flying afterward.

No drawings were held as no Tooth Fairies were available/ were advised to pick up the fuel or the hobby store vouchers. Perhaps, it would be nice if we had double drawings at the next meeting.
